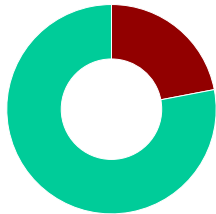

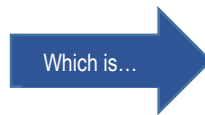

22% of Medicare beneficiaries have depression



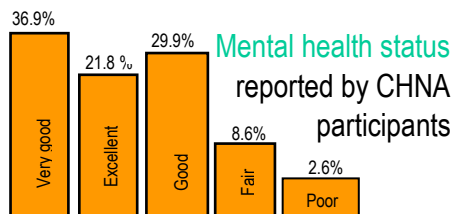
That's over **4,000** Vanderburgh County residents diagnosed with depression

deaths per 100,000 population

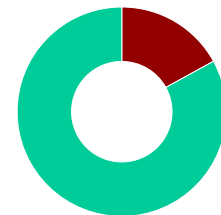


17% of residents experience frequent mental distress
